

Follow up on Nidera specific instance

With a view to learning from the handling of the specific instance and monitor progress on the Nidera NCP dialogue, the NCP invited parties to inform the NCP on their practical experiences with the Enterprise's human rights policy one year after publication of the Final Statement in this case. In March 2013 the Netherlands NCP received the mutual report of both notifiers (SOMO - www.somo.nl, CEDHA – www.cedha.org.ar, INCASUR and Oxfam Novib) and Nidera B.V. covering practical experiences on all the main terms of the mutually satisfactory agreement. In addition Nidera B.V. provided information on initiatives implemented during the last year as part of their CSR approach. This includes a company-wide Nidera Human Rights Policy and a Human Rights Due Diligence Procedure (both available at www.nidera.com) implemented within the company.

The NCP wishes to congratulate parties involved with the very positive progress report. It is very comforting to see that the stakeholder dialogue did not stop at the end of the NCP procedure, but seem to be intensified. This is a very good example of the basic assumption behind CSR that it must be stakeholder driven. The handling of the notification by all parties can be an example for other companies.
