OECD Guidelines for MNEs



Digitalisation is not mentioned, however:

- ⇒ Touches upon **all** areas of interaction between the firm and society;
- ⇒ **Due diligence** for the entire supply chain;
- ⇒ Guidelines are **technology-neutral**;
- ⇒ Mandate of the **NCPs** extends also to the **digital context**.





- etc.




